Diversion formed in Chicago in February 2012 after Nathan Greenhalgh and Taylor Noelle met at a recording studio open house.

Initially brought together by their shared love of acoustic music, Greenhalgh and Noelle began jamming a month later at Greenhalgh's home studio in Wicker Park, using original songs written by both. Excited by the results of the jam sessions, Greenhalgh and Noelle formed Diversion and began writing songs together.

In June 2012 Diversion began recording an EP, *Highlife*, completed in January 2013 and released digitally on iTunes, Amazon and other online music stores.
